WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW FOR HASSLE-FREE COLLECTION

Please place your trash bin at the edge of your property allowing 6ft of clearance on each side and 2ft of clearance at the back. This ensures the mechanical arm does not damage nearby objects and can safely collect and empty your bin.

Your bin must be front-facing to the road (wheels and hinge side at the back).

All household waste should be in trash bags and not placed loosely in the bins.

Do NOT place Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) in your bins. To learn more about HHW and how to dispose of it properly, please visit www.churchillfalls.ca.

Please do not leave empty bins at your curbside.
Collection becomes less efficient for our staff if they are collecting at residential units with empty bins.

By following these guidelines you ensure your garbage will be collected each collection day. If your bin has not been emptied, you will find a tag on your bin explaining why we were unable to collect at your residence for that particular day.





GARBAGE BIN INFORMATION

Size

These specialized bins come in a variety of sizes but not all are compatible with our automated lifting system. Please ensure you purchase a bin that is no smaller than 64 gallons. Smaller bins slip through the mechanical arm. There is no maximum size restriction.

Garbage bins must:

- meet all ANSI (American National Standards Institute) requirements for safety and lifter system capability;
- · contain a hinged cover;
- be maintained in good condition.
