



SAFETY RULES & REGULATIONS

TERRY SMITH MEMORIAL ARENA



GENERAL SAFETY RULES

- Anyone with COVID-19 symptoms is **NOT** permitted in the facility.
- Everyone entering the facility **MUST** sanitize their hands.
- Masks are mandatory and must be worn at all times, with the exception of those on the ice surface.
- A maximum of **200 spectators** are permitted in the bleachers at one time for any activity. (Maximum of 25 bubbles)
- Dressing rooms are closed to the public. Skaters will use designated bleachers to put on and remove skates and **MUST** social distance.
- Dressing room washrooms are **NOT** available for public use.
- Please use designated spectator seating only and social distance.
- Standing at the ice rink glass is **NOT** permitted.
- Public washrooms are open for all patrons.
- Social distancing is in effect throughout the facility, including while seated in the bleachers.
- At the sound of the horn, everyone will have 10 minutes to vacate the facility. This is to allow time for sanitization and cleaning between activities.

PUBLIC SKATING

- A maximum of **25 skaters** will be permitted on the ice at one time.
- All participants **MUST** register at churchillfalls.ca and submit a health screening form prior to entering the arena. If you are unable to attend your registered time, please take the time to **CANCEL** your timeslot to allow others to attend.
- All spectators of public skate **MUST** register at churchillfalls.ca and submit a health screening form prior to entering the arena. If you are unable to attend your registered time, please take the time to **CANCEL** your timeslot to allow others to attend.
- Skaters will use designated bleachers to put on and remove skates, **MUST** social distance, and **MUST** wear a mask.
- Skaters **MUST** remain socially distanced in the bleachers until it is time to enter the ice surface.
- Masks will be required to be worn until the skater is ready to enter the ice surface.

ORGANIZED SPORT & USER GROUPS

- Organizers are required to submit a safety control plan to the Town Office prior to any organized activities. For more information please contact our Town Office by calling 925.3335.
- A maximum of **50 participants** (athletes, coaches, volunteers, etc.) are permitted on the ice at one time.
- Sport organizers are required to provide all athletes, volunteers, and participants with a health screening tool which **MUST** be submitted by attending members and athletes prior to each activity. Organizers are responsible for maintaining health screening records.
- Athletes must remain socially distanced in the bleachers until it is time to enter the ice surface.
- Masks are required until the participant is ready to enter the ice.
- Dressing rooms are open to **COACHES ONLY**. Coaches must socially distance using designated areas in the dressing rooms.
- Volunteers who are required to attend practices or ice sessions will be assigned designated areas with social distancing in effect.

⚠️ If you, or a member of your organized activity, are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms while at our facility, ensure the symptomatic person is wearing a mask and a Recreation Attendant is notified immediately. Symptomatic persons will be placed in an isolation room with COVID-19 safety protocols followed.
