



Canadian Navigable Waters Act

Churchill Falls (Labrador) Corporation Limited hereby gives notice that an application has been made to the Minister of Transport, pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* for approval of the work described herein and its site and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 7(2) of the said Act, **Churchill Falls (Labrador) Corporation Limited** has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Common Project Search Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under registry number 3185, or, under the NPP File Number 2021-203999 a description of the following work, its site and plans:

- Bridge Removal and Replacement

in, on, over, under, through or across Grace Lake River, Labrador, along the 735 kV transmission line approximately 8 km north of the Quebec border and approximately 190 km south of the Churchill Falls Hydro Power Plant facility at 52° 8' 46.00" N, 65° 36' 22.00" W.
