

**Public Safety Advisory:  
Potential Controlled Water Release at Jacopie Spillway**

*Tuesday, December 31, 2024* – The Churchill Falls Generating Station is advising the public of a potential controlled water release to occur from the upper Churchill reservoir at the Jacopie Spillway over the next 72 hours. This is due to icing on the 735kV system and unseasonable mild temperatures.

As a precaution, the public is advised to avoid the following and surrounding areas:

- Jacopie and Whitefish Spillways;
- The Churchill River Bed downstream of the Jacopie Spillway;
- The Churchill River Walking Trail;
- East and West Forebay Water Storage areas located north of the community of Churchill Falls.

We continue to carefully monitor our reservoir systems to ensure we are maintaining safe water levels. We will update the public once the potential has ended or if a controlled release will take place.

Safety is always our number one priority. The public is advised to always use extreme caution around dykes, dams and spillways as water levels in these areas are always unpredictable.

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
