

**Public Safety Advisory:  
Controlled Water Release at Jacopie Spillway**

*January 2, 2025* – The Churchill Falls Generating Station is advising the public of a controlled water release to occur from the upper Churchill reservoir at the Jacopie Spillway. The public will be notified when the controlled release of water has ended.

Please avoid the following areas:

Jacopie and Whitefish Spillways;

The Churchill River Bed downstream of the Jacopie Spillway;

The Churchill River Walking Trail;

East and West Forebay Water Storage areas located north of the community of Churchill Falls.

The controlled water release is due to icing on the 735kV system and unseasonable mild temperatures.

Safety is always our number one priority. The public is advised to always use extreme caution around dykes, dams and spillways as water levels in these areas are always unpredictable.
