

BEHAVIOUR AGREEMENT

Please read this agreement with your child and be sure they understand the guidelines.

This is to ensure each child understands the rules they are expected to follow while at Summer Program; and guardians understand that children not following these rules can result in dismissal from the program.

- ____ I will listen to Summer Program leaders and follow their directions.
- ____ I will respect other people's belongings, including those that belong to Summer Program.
- ____ I will keep my hands and feet to myself.
- ____ I will use appropriate language.
- ____ I will be respectful towards my peers and be nice to everyone.
- ____ I will respect other's feelings by having a positive attitude.
- ____ I will do my best to participate, and try activities planned by Summer Program Staff.

Depending on the severity of the situation or if the behavior persists, one or more of the following consequences will be taken:

- ✓ Leaders/staff will discuss behaviour with the participant.
- ✓ Leaders/staff will discuss the behavior with the parent/guardian.
- ✓ The child will be sent home immediately for the day.
- ✓ In extreme cases child will be sent home and not allowed to return to Summer Program.

Some examples of unacceptable behaviour:

- ✓ Swearing at a leader/staff member
- ✓ Fighting, roughhousing, or engaging in unsafe behavior which includes hitting a leader or any other participant with the intent to hurt
- ✓ Threatening or bullying other participants
- ✓ Spitting on other participants or staff/leaders
- ✓ Being disrespectful to staff/leaders.

Should any of these actions be witnessed, the child will be asked to leave the program immediately. They will be permitted back once an apology has been extended to the recipient(s) of the behaviour. If the child continues to display unacceptable behaviour, the child will be removed from the program for the remainder of the summer.

THIS FORM REQUIRES THE SIGNATURE OF A PARENT/GUARDIAN BEFORE A CHILD CAN ATTEND THE SUMMER RECREATION PROGRAM.
